Background

Nestled just miles away from the Pacific Ocean, Leyda Valley is unique for its location. These climate characteristics allow grape ripening to take place at a slower pace, prompting a robust development of aromas and fruity flavors, and ensuring a perfect balance of sugar and acidity in the wines.

Tasting Notes

Eye: Medium red brick tone characteristic of bourgogne pinot noir

Nose: A medium body pinot, lacey with delicate texture

Mouth: A bright cherry flavor that finishes long & tangy, framed by supple tannins and a bit of vanilla!

Pair: With rich complex cheeses, fatty fish, roasted vegetables and all grilled meat!
